Outlining operational GRIPAVI results

- Cooperation between veterinarians, laboratories, ecologists, doctors and farmers was strengthened
- Staff from veterinary, parks and wildlife services more sensitized to the importance of the wild/domestic/human interface
- Scientific and technical training highly appreciated
- Avenues for more targeted surveillance strategies
- Some successful surveillance network for NCD and Al are model to be extended to new areas and diseases
- Reinforcement of laboratory equipment and support
- Swine influenza is a new problem to be considered (e.g. Vietnam)

New questions arised

- How to improve vaccination efficiency and case reporting ?
- What happens for virus circulation when farmer sell sick animals?
- Are local avian race more resistant to virus?
- Extrapolation of our results to other areas?
- Usefulness of wild bird surveillance? If yes how to improve it?
- More investigation on NCD circulating genotypes
